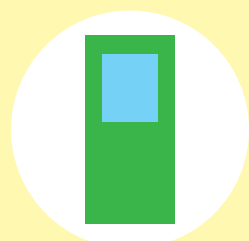

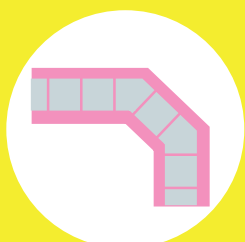
Replace old windows with Energy Star windows.

Install enough for your climate zone - in your walls and attic to make a huge difference in your heating costs, not to mention your comfort.



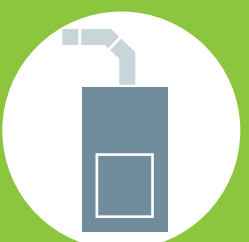
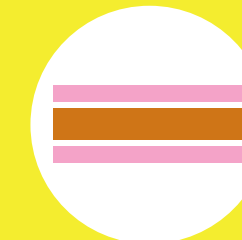
Replace old doors with Energy Star version.

which are specially designed to save on water and heat but still perform well.



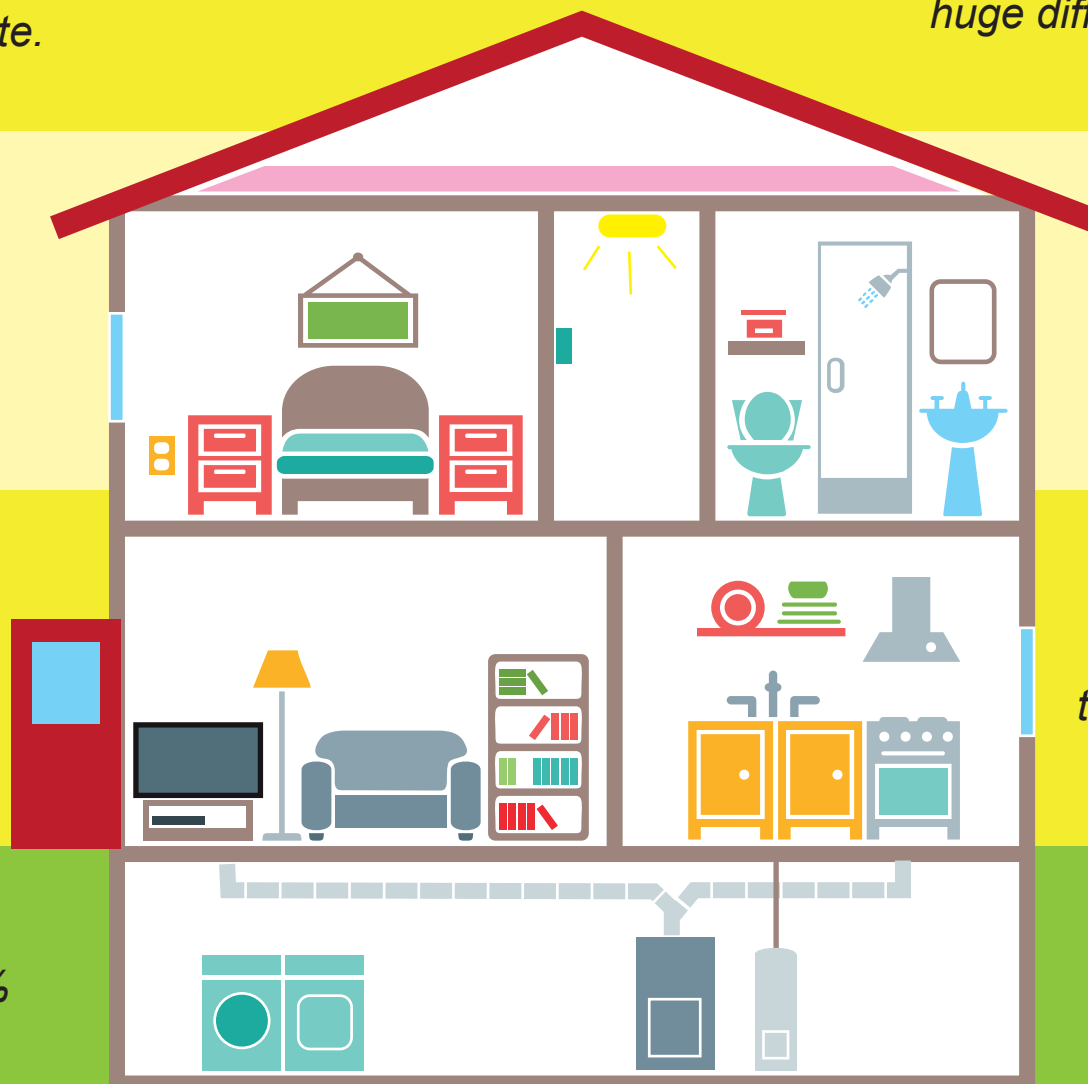
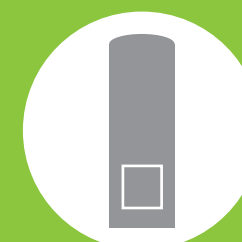
Insulate and tape air ducts especially in unheated spaces.
