

SOLAR FARM IS NOW LIVE!

As of February 1st, 2021, the 2.2 megawatt solar farm has been sending power into the local electricity grid. When combined with ATCO's neighbouring 600-kilowatt solar project built in 2019, the community will receive 25 percent of its electricity supply from solar energy.



GARDENING IN WINTER



On February 25th, ACFN started their first crop of 2021 in the Growcer seacan at the K'ai Tailé Market. Cathwyn and Michael, staff of the market, planted over 600 seeds of parsley, lettuce and spinach. This is part of ACFN's project to grow vegetables using hydroponics (soilless planting).

SOLAR CABINS APPROVED YEAR 2

The cabin solar electricity program has been approved for another year. These systems will power lights and run other small appliances, reducing the need for fuel, reducing noise from generators and reduces greenhouse gas emissions. For those members interested, visit our website.

FireSmart work has been completed around the community of Allison Bay, north of Fort Chipewyan. The crews are now working along the road into Allison Bay.

This work helps communities in forested areas to reduce the risk of wildfire to their homes by removing dead trees and debris.
